5 George IV – Chapter 25

An Act to alter and amend an Act, intituled, "An Art to repeal all the Laws now in force relating to the establishment, regulation and improvement, of the Great Roads of communication through the Province, and to make more effectual provision for the same." Passed 11th March, 1824.

Whereas it is expedient to authorize and empower the President or Commander-in-Chief for the time being, to displace and remove any of the Supervisors appointed under and by virtue of an Act made and passed in the third year of the Reign, of His present Majesty, intituled, "An Act to repeal all the Laws now in force relating to the establishment, regulation and improvement, of the Great Roads of communication through the Province, and to make more effectual provision for the same"—

Be it enacted by the President, Council, and Assembly, That it shall and may be lawful for the President or Commander-in-Chief for the time being, by and with the advice of His Majesty's Council, to displace and remove any Supervisor appointed under the said recited Act, in case it shall be necessary or expedient so to do, and, by and with the advice aforesaid, to nominate and appoint some other fit person to be Supervisor in the room of such person so displaced and removed, in like manner as is provided in and by the fifteenth Section of the said recited Act, in case of the death, removal from the district, or refusal to act, of any Supervisor.
