6 George IV – Chapter 10

An Act to authorize the Justices of the Peace for Queen County, to assess the Inhabitants for erecting and building a Gaol in the said County. Passed 17th March 1825.

Whereas the Gaol in the County of Queens is found insufficient for the purposes intended, and whereas it is expedient that a Gaol should be erected in the said County.

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That the Justices of the Peace for the said County at any General Sessions of the Peace hereafter to be holden, or at any Special Session for that purpose convened and holden, or the major part of them, be and they are hereby authorised and empowered to contract and agree with able and sufficient workmen for building and finishing a Gaol in the said County, and to agree for such sum or sums of money as to them may seem meet in order to carry their object into effect; and the said Justices are hereby authorized and empowered to make a rate and assessment of any such not exceeding the sum of five hundred pounds as they in their discretion may think necessary for the erecting and finishing a Gaol in the said County, the said sum or sums to be assessed, levied, collected and paid in such proportion and in the same manner as any other County Rates can or may be assessed, levied, collected and paid under and by virtue of any Act or Acts in force in this Province for assessing, levying and collecting of Rates for public charges.
