6 George IV – Chapter 6

An Act to authorise the Justices of the Peace for the County of York to levy a further assessment on the said County, towards paying off the debt due for the County Court-House. Passed 17th March 1825.

Whereas there is a considerable balance remains due and unpaid of the purchase money of the York County Court House.

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Assembly, That the Justices of the Peace for the County of York, or the major part of them, at any General Session of the Peace to be holden for the said County, be, and they are hereby authorized and empowered, if they, shall see fit, to make a Rate and Assessment on the said County of a sum not exceeding Five Hundred Pounds to assist them to pay off the debt owing for the County Court House; the said sum to be assessed, levied, collected and paid in such proportion and in the same manner as any other County Rates for Public Charges can or may be assessed, levied, collected and paid under and by virtue of any Act or Acts in force in this Province for assessing, levying and collecting of Rates for Public Charges.
