7 George IV – Chapter 17

An Act to incorporate the Minister and Elders of the Kirk of Scotland in the town of St. Andrews. Passed the 7th of March, 1826.

Whereas sundry Inhabitants of the Town of Saint Andrews, in the County of Charlotte, being of the Profession of Worship, approved of by the General Assembly, of the Church of Scotland, have procured a commodious and handsome building, for a place of Public Worship, in connection with the said Church of Scotland; And whereas Minister and Elders have been duly appointed and chosen, according to the usages of the said Church of Scotland, and the said Minister has been duly licenced to officiate in the said Church.

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Assembly, That the said Minister and Elders, shall be, and they are hereby Incorporated by the name of the "Minister and Elders of the Kirk of Scotland," in the Town of Saint Andrews, and shall by that name, have perpetual succession, and be enabled to sue, and be sued, implead, and be impleaded, answer and be answered unto, and to receive, take and hold Gifts and Grants of Land, and real Estate; the annual income of which not to exceed five hundred pounds, and also, to accept of, and receive donations for the endowment of the same.
