7 George IV – Chapter 2

An Act to continue the Act intituled “An Act, to regulate the cutting of Saw Logs, on the River Magagaudavic, and its various branches.” Passed the 7th March 1826.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That an Act passed in the third year of the Reign of His present Majesty King George the Fourth, intituled “An Act to regulate the cutting of Saw Logs on the River Magagaudavic and its various branches” be and the same is hereby continued and declared to be in full force until the first day of April one thousand eight hundred and thirty-one, and no longer.
