7 George IV – Chapter 3

An Act to continue; an Act intituled "An Act to empower and authorize the Justices of the County of Westmorland, at their General Sessions of the Peace, to regulate the grazing and depasturing the several Marshes Low Lands or Meadows, within the said County." Passed the 7th of March 1826.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the fifty-fourth year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Third, intituled, "An Act to empower and authorize the Justices of the County of Westmoreland at their General Sessions of the Peace, to regulate the grazing and depasturing of the several Marshes, Low Lands or Meadows within the said County," be, and the same is hereby continued and declared to be in full force for five years and no longer.
