7 George IV – Chapter 9

An Act to authorize the Justices of the Peace for the County of Northumberland, to levy an assessment to pay off in County Debt. Passed the 7th of March, 1826.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That the Justices of the Peace for the County of Northumberland or the major part of them at any General Sessions of the Peace, or at any Special Session for that purpose expressly convened and holden, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to make a fare and assessment of a sum not exceeding Six hundred pounds for the purpose of paying off the debt due by the said County; the said sum to be assessed, levied, collected and paid, in such proportion and in the same manner as any other County Rates for public charges, can or may be assessed, levied, collected and paid, under and by virtue of any Act or Acts in force in this Province, for assessing, levying and collecting of Rates for public charges.
