8 George IV – Chapter 1

An Act to continue as Act intitaled "An Act to authorize the Justices of the County of Northumberland to regulate the grazing and depasturing of certain Tracts of land within that County." Passed the 19th March, 1827.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Assembly, That an Act passed in the seventh year of the Reign of His Majesty King George the Fourth, intituled, "An Act to authorize the Justices of the County of Northumberland, to regulate the grazing and depasturing of certain tracts of Land within that County," be, and the same is hereby continued and declared to be in full force for one year.
