9 George IV – Chapter 15

An Act further to continue an Act intituled, “An Act to provide for the erecting of Fences with Gates across Highways leading through Interval lands in Queens County and the County of Sunbury, where the same may be found necessary;” and to extend the provisions of the same to Kings County. Passed 5th April, 1828.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the fiftieth year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the: Third, intituled “An Act to provide for the erection of Fences with Gates across Highways leading through Interval lands in Queen’s County and the County of Sunbury, where the same may be found necessary,” and also an Act passed in the third year of His Majesty’s Reign to extend the provisions of the same to King’s County; be, and the same are hereby further continued and declared to be in full force, until the first day of April which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four.
