9 & 10 George IV – Chapter 13

An Act to extend the provisions of the several Acts regulating the exportation of Fish, to all Pickled Fish intended for exportation. Passed 10th February, 1829.

Whereas it is deemed expedient to extend the provisions of the several Acts now in force for regulating the exportation of Fish, to all pickled Fish;

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Assembly. That the several provisions of an Act passed in the ninth Year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act in amendment of the Acts regulating the exportation of Fish," and an Act passed in the fifty-ninth Year of the Reign, of His late Majesty, King George the Third, intituled, "An Act to regulate the exportation of Fish, and to repeal the Laws now in force relating thereto," be, and the same are hereby extended to Alewives, Gaspereaux, Mackarel, and other pickled Fish, as fully as if the same had been particularly specified in such Acts.
