9 & 10 George IV – Chapter 18

**An Act relative to the Election of Charter Officers for Guy's Ward and Brook's Ward, in the City of Saint John. Passed 10th February 1829.**

Whereas by the second Section of an Act passed in the forty-third Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Third, intituled, "An Act for altering the division of four of the Wards in the City of Saint John and for changing the mode of Elections, within the two other Wards in the said City," an alteration was made in the mode of electing Charter Officers for Guy's Ward and Brook's Ward; which alteration, in consequence of the increase of Population in the said Wards is now found inconvenient, and the Mayor, Aldermen and Commonalty of the City of Saint John have by their Petition to the General Assembly prayed that the said second Section of the said Act be repealed:

- I. Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Assembly, That the second Section of the Act passed in the forty-third Year of the Reign of His late Majesty, intituled, "An Act for altering the division of four of the Wards in the City of Saint John, and for changing the mode of Elections within the two other Wards in the said City," be, and the same is hereby repealed.
- II. Provided always, and be it further enacted, That the present Charter Officers of the said two Wards shall continue, and remain in office until others are duly elected in their stead, at the time and in the manner directed by the Charter of the said City, any thing herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding.
