9 & 10 George IV – Chapter 2

An Act further to continue an Act, intituled, "An Act more effectually to provide for the support of a Nightly Watch in the City of Saint John." Passed 10th February, 1829.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Assembly, That an Act passed in the fiftysixth Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Third, intituled, "An Act more effectually to provide for the support of a nightly Watch in the City of Saint John," be, and the same is hereby further continued and declared to be in force until the first day of April, which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty-two.
