An Act to continue an Act, intituled, "An Act for the regulation of Booms for securing Masts, Logs, and Lumber, in certain parts of the County of Northumberland." Passed 10th February, 1829.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That an Act passed in the fourth Year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act for the regulation of Booms for securing Masts, Logs, and Lumber, in certain parts of the County of Northumberland," be, and the same is hereby continued and declared to be in full force until the tenth day of May, which will be in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four.
