10 & 11 George IV – Chapter 25 (Session 1)

An Act further to continue certain Acts providing for the more effectually repairing the Streets and Bridges in the City and County of Saint John. Passed 8th March, 1830.

Be it enacted by the President, Council, and Assembly, That an Act passed in the Fiftieth year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Third, intituled, "An Act to provide for the more effectually repairing the Streets and Bridges in the City and County of Saint John," also, an Act passed in the Fifty-eighth year of the Reign of His said late Majesty, intituled, "An Act further to continue and amend an Act to provide for the more effectually repairing the Streets and Bridges in the City and County of Saint John," and also, a certain other Act passed in the Fifth year of the Reign of His present Majesty King George the Fourth, intituled, "An Act further to continue and amend the Acts for the more effectually repairing the Streets and Bridges in the City and County of Saint John," and also the third Section of an Act made and passed in the Ninth year of the Reign of His said Majesty King George the Fourth, intituled "An Act to continue until the first day of April One thousand eight hundred and thirty, certain Acts providing for the more effectually repairing the Streets and Bridges in the City and County of Saint John, and to amend the same," be, and the same are hereby continued until the first day of April, which will be in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty two.
