An Act to revive an Act, intituled An Act for regulating the Courts of Law established in the several Counties for the Trial of Causes to the Value of Forty Shillings. Passed 25th March 1831.

Be it enacted by the President, Council, and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the Twenty sixth Year of the Reign of His Majesty King George the Third, intituled *An Act for regulating the Courts of Law established in the several Counties for the Trial of Causes to the Value of Forty Shillings*, be and the same is hereby revived and declared to be in full Force for the Term of Two Years, so far as the same relates to the City of Saint John.
