2 William IV – Chapter 3 Session 1

An Act to continue the Acts relative to the Herring Fishery in the County of Charlotte. Passed 27th February 1832.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Council, and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the Eighth Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Fourth, Intituled *An Act to regulate the Herring Fishery in the Parishes of Grand Manan, West-Isles, Campo Bello [Campobello], Pennfield and Saint George, in the County of Charlotte, and to provide for the Inspection of smoked Herrings in the said Parishes, also an Act made and passed in the First Year of the Reign of His present Majesty King William the Fourth, intituled <i>An Act to amend an Act to regulate the Herring Fishery in the Parishes of Grand Manan, West Isles, Campo Bello, Pennfield and Saint George in the County of Charlotte, and to provide for the Inspection of smoked Herrings in the said Parishes,* be and the same are hereby continued for the Term of Two Years.
