2 William IV – Chapter 31 Session 1

An Act further to continue the Acts relative to Streets and Highways in the City and County of Saint John. Passed 9th March 1882.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Council, and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the Fiftieth Year of the Reign of King George the Third, intituled *An Act to provide for the more effectually repairing the Streets and Bridges in the City and County of Saint John*; and an Act made and passed in the Fifty eighth Year of the same Reign, intituled *An Act further to continue and amend an Act to provide for the more effectually repairing the Streets and Bridges in the City and County of Saint John*; and an Act made and passed in the Fifth Year of the Reign of King George the Fourth, intituled *An Act further to continue and amend the Acts for more effectually repairing the Streets and Bridges in the City and County of Saint John*; and the Third Section of an Act made and passed in the Ninth Year of the last mentioned Reign, intituled *An Act to continue until the First Day of April One thousand eight hundred and thirty certain Acts providing for the more effectually repairing the Streets and Bridges in the City and County of Saint John*, and to amend the same, be and the same are hereby continued until the First Day of April One thousand eight hundred and thirty six.
