3 William IV – Chapter 34

An Act to authorize the Justices of the Peace for the County of Charlotte to assess the Inhabitants of Saint Stephen in the said Comity for the Purpose therein mentioned. Passed 19th March 1833.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That the Justices of the Peace for the said County, at any General Sessions of the Peace hereafter to be holden, or the major Part of them, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to make a Rate and Assessment on the Inhabitants of Saint Stephen in the said County of Charlotte, of any Sum not exceeding Ninety Pounds, for the Purpose of paying the Purchase Money of the reserved Land at Mill town in the said Parish of Saint Stephen recently sold at public Sale; the said Sum to be assessed, levied, collected and paid in such Proportion and in the same Manner as any other Parish Rates can or may be assessed, levied, collected and paid, under any Act or Acts in Force in this Province for assessing, levying and collecting of Rates in this Province for public Charges.
