An Act to continue an Act passed in the Second Year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled An Act to empower the Owners of the Saw Mill al the Rolling Dam on the River Digdeguash, in the County of Charlotte, to erect a Boom for the securing of Saw Logs on the said River. Passed 22d March 1834.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the Second Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled *An Act to empower the Owners of the Saw Mill at the Rolling Dam on the River Digdeguash, in the County of Charlotte, to erect a Boom for the securing of Saw Logs on the said River,* be and the same is hereby continued, and declared to be in Force, until the First Day of February which will be in the Year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and forty.
