4 William IV – Chapter 37

An Act to continue the Acts now in Force for the Relief of insolvent confined Debtors. Passed 22d March 1834.

Whereas the Acts now in Force for the Relief of insolvent confined Debtors will expire on the First Day of April next: And Whereas it is expedient that the same be continued;

I. Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the Tenth and Eleventh Years of the Reign of King George the Fourth, intituled *An Act to repeal all the Acts now in Force, for the Support and Relief of confined Debtors, and to make other and more effectual Provisions in lieu thereof*; and also an Act made and passed in the First Year of the Reign of King William the Fourth, intituled *An Act to amend the Laws in Force relating to insolvent confined Debtors*; and also an Act made and passed in the Second Year of the Reign of King William the Fourth, intituled *An Act to continue and amend the Acts relating to the Support and Relief of confined Debtors*; and also an Act made and passed in the Third Year of the Reign of King William the Fourth, intituled *An Act further to amend the Act relating to the Support and Relief of confined Debtors*, be and the same are hereby severally continued and declared to be in full Force until die First Day of April which will be in the Year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty six and no longer.
