4 William IV – Chapter 5

An Act to authorize the Justices of the Peace in the County of Kent, to levy an Assessment upon the Inhabitants of the said County, to discharge the Debts due from the same. Passed 22d March 1834.

Whereas the Justices of the Peace of the County of Kent have heretofore levied the whole Sum which they were empowered to raise by Assessment: And Whereas the same has been found insufficient to discharge the Debts due from the said County;

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That the said Justices of the Peace for the said County of Kent, at any General Sessions of the Peace hereafter to be holden, or any Special Sessions of the Peace to be for that Purpose convened, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to make such further Rate and Assessment, not exceeding Three hundred Pounds, as they in their Discretion may think necessary for the paying off the Debts due from the said County, in such Parts and at such Times as the said Justices or the major Part of them then and there assembled may think necessary for the Purpose of paying off the Debt now due, or to become due; the said Sum or Sums to be assessed, levied, collected and paid under and by virtue of any Act or Acts which are now or hereafter may be in Force in this Province for assessing, levying and collecting of Rates for Public Charges.
