4 William IV – Chapter 9

**An Act to protect the Gaspereau Fishery in the Harbour and River of Miramichi in the County of Northumberland. Passed 22d March 1834.**

Whereas the Gaspereaux Fisheries in the Harbour and River of Miramichi, are likely to become seriously injured, in consequence of the Catch being continued to too late a Period in the Season;

I. Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That from and after the passing of this Act no Gaspereaux shall be taken in the Bay, Harbour, or River of Miramichi, or its Branches, within the said County, after the Twenty fifth Day of June in each and every Year, under the Penalty of Ten Pounds for each and every Offence against the Provisions of this Act, to be recovered and applied in the same Manner as the Penalties are directed to be recovered under any of the Laws now in Force for the Protection of the Fisheries in this Province.

II. And be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That no Gaspereaux caught in the River Miramichi or any of its Branches shall be applied for the Purposes, of Manure, under der the Penalty of Forty Shillings for each and every Offence, to be recovered and applied in like Manner as the Penalties in the First Section of this Act are directed to be recovered and applied.
