## An Act to alter the boundary line between certain Parishes in the County of Westmorland. Passed 17th March 1835.

Whereas the boundary line between the parishes of Monckton and Dorchester in the County of Westmorland as at present established, has been found inconvenient;

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That from and after the seventeenth day of November next, all that tract of Land In the present Parish of Dorchester, in the County of Westmorland, which lies to the north of a line commencing at Fox Creek, on the northern line of the Des Barres tract, so called, and running thence easterly along the said line to the extension thereof on the Memramcook river, thence along the prolongation of said line until it strikes the western line of Shediac Parish, shall be annexed to and form a part of the Parish of Monckton [Moncton] in said County.
