

Acts of the General Assembly of His Majesty's Province of New-Brunswick passed in the year 1835. Fredericton, NB: John Simpson, Printer to the King's Most Excellent Majesty, 1835.

5 William IV – Chapter 28 (Session 1)

An Act to authorise the Grand Jurors of the several Counties within this Province to inspect the Public Accounts. Passed 17th March 1835.

Whereas it is desirable that full publicity should be given to the accounts of the receipts and expenditures of public monies with, in the several Counties in this Province, with a view to prevent abuses therein;

I. Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That once in each year, at the General Sessions of the Peace in each County at which Parish Officers are appointed, it shall be the duty of the Justice at such General Sessions to cause a full, detailed and particular account of all the receipts and expenditures of public monies within such Counties for the past year to be laid before the Grand Jury for their inspection and examination; and such Grand Jury may make such representation and presentment to the Court thereupon as to them shall seem meet.

II. And be it enacted, That this Act shall continue and be in force until the first day of April which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty.
