5 William IV – Chapter 5 (Session 2)

An Act for altering the times of holding the Terms of the General Sessions of the Peace and Inferior Courts of Common Pleas of the Count of Carleton. Passed 24th June 1835.

Whereas the times appointed for holding the Terms of the General Sessions of the Peace and Inferior Courts of Common Pleas of the County of Carleton has been found inconvenient; for remedy whereof;

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That the said Terms of the General Sessions of the Peace and Inferior Courts of Common Pleas appointed to be holden on the first Tuesdays in January and June in each and every year, shall hereafter be holden on the fourth Tuesdays in January and June in each and every year, any Law to the contrary thereof notwithstanding: Provided always, That no Process shall abate or other business of what nature or kind soever be discontinued by reason of the alterations of said Terms, but shall and may be proceeded upon, beard and determined at the times herein appointed in the same manner as they might have been proceeded upon had no alteration been made.
