5 William IV – Chapter 6 (Session 2)

An Act to amend, An Act to repeal all the Laws now in force relating to Saint Andrew's Church in the City of Saint John, and for incorporating sundry Persons Pewholders of the said Church, and of the several Churches erected or to be erected in the Province in connection with the Church of Scotland. Passed 24th June 1835.

Whereas it is considered expedient to amend the ninth Section of an Act made and passed in the second year of the reign of His present Majesty, intituled An Act to repeal all the Laws now in force relating to Saint Andrew's Church in the City of Saint John, and for incorporating sundry Persons Pewholders of the said Church, and of the several Churches erected or to be erected in the Province in connection with the Church of Scotland by repealing such, part thereof as excepts the operation of the eighth section of the same Act as therein expressed;

Be it therefore coasted by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That such exception contained in said ninth section in the words following, that is to say, "save and except only the eighth section of this Act" be and the same is hereby repealed, sad that such eighth Section do extend and be construed in all respects as if the said exception were not therein inserted.
