6 William IV – Chapter 9

An Act to establish the toad leading from Houlton to Woodstock one of the great roads of communication in this Province. Passed 8th March 1836.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislatives Council and Assembly, That the road leading from Houlton, commencing at the boundary line between this Province and the State of Maine, through the Richmond settlement, to the great road leading through Woodstock in the County of Carleton, be and the same is hereby established one of the great roads of communication in this Province.
