1 Victoria – Chapter 28

An Act to amend the Law relating to the inspection of public Accounts by Grand Juries, so far as relates to the County of Charlotte. Passed 9th March 1838.

Whereas the time prescribed for the Grand Jury inspecting the public accounts by an Act passed the seventh year of the reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, intituled "An Act to amend an Act, intituled 'An Act to authorize the Grand Jurors in the several Counties within this Province to inspect the public Accounts,' " is found inconvenient in the County of Charlotte;

- I. Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That in the said County of Charlotte, it shall be the duty of the Justices of the Peace to cause the accounts of the receipts and expenditure of the public monies to be laid before the Grand Jury for their inspection and examination, according to the provisions of the said recited Act, once in each year, at the general Sessions of the Peace at which Parish officers are appointed, instead of the next succeeding Sessions as prescribed in the same Act continuance of the said recited Act.
- II. And be it enacted, That this Act shall continue and be in force during the continuance of the said recited act.
