3 Victoria – Chapter 71

An Act to amend the Act to alter the times for the appointment of Sheriffs and Supervisors of Great Roads. Passed 31st March 1840.

I. Be it enacted by the lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That the eighteenth section of an Act made and passed in seventh year of the Reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, intituled "An Act relating to the Great Roads of Communication through this Province;" and also so much of an Act made and passed in the first year of the Reign of Her present Majesty Queen Victoria, intituled "An Act to alter the times for the appointment of Sheriffs and Supervisors of Great Roads," as applied to the appointment of Supervisors, be and the same is hereby repealed.

II. And be it further enacted, that the several and respective Supervisors of Great Roads shall be appointed for and during the space of one year from the first of April in each and every year, and such appointments shall be made in the month of March in each and every year and in case of death or removal from the Province, or refusal of any such Supervisor to act, or for other sufficient cause shewn to the Lieutenant Governor or Commander in Chief, for the removal of any Supervisor or Supervisors, it shall and may be lawful for the Lieutenant Governor or Commander in Chief for the time being, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, to nominate and appoint for the remainder of the year some other fit and proper person to be Supervisor in the room of such person so deceased, or removed from the Province, or who shall refuse to act, or be removed from other sufficient cause.

III. And be it enacted, That when it shall be made to appear to the Lieutenant Governor or Commander in Chief for the time being, that any Supervisor has neglected to render to the Secretary of the Province, accounts, duly vouched and attested, of the expenditure of all monies received by him from the Treasury of the Province in the year preceding the commencement of the annual Session of the Legislature, at an early period of such annual Session, or who shall have drawn monies from the Treasury contrary to the rules made by the Lieutenant Governor in Council for the government of Supervisors, then and in such case it shall and may be lawful for the Lieutenant Governor or Commander in Chief for the time being, and he is hereby authorised and empowered, to displace such Supervisor, and appoint another fit person to be Supervisor in his stead.
