4 Victoria – Chapter 10

An Act to provide for more effectually repairing the Streets and Bridges in a part of the Parish of Saint Stephens. Passed 19th March 1841.

I. Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That all persons liable to perform labor on the Streets and Highways in that part of the Parish of Saint Stephen, in the County of Charlotte, which is included within the following limits, to wit: commencing at the mouth of Dennis' or Porter's Mill Stream, and extending to the residence of Robert M. Todd in Mill Town, and between the River Saint Croix and a line drawn one mile back from the said River, shall in future in lieu of such labor annually pay the sum of two shillings and six pence for each and every day's labor such persons are respectively liable to perform.

II. And be it enacted, That the monies required to be paid in virtue of this Act shall be assessed, levied and collected in the same manner as any Parish or County rates are assessed, levied and collected by virtue of any Law now in force, or which may hereafter be in force for that purpose in this Province; and when collected, such monies shall be paid over to the Commissioners of Highways for the said Parish, to be by them expended on the Streets and Bridges within the above described limits, in the same manner as any monies by them received in lieu of labor have been hitherto by Law expended.
