4 Victoria – Chapter 11

An Act to authorize the Justices of the Peace for the County of Charlotte to assess the Parish of Saint Stephen, in the said County, for the erection of a Wharf on the Public Landing at Salt Water in said Parish. Passed 19th March 1841.

I. Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That the Justices of the Peace for the County of Charlotte, or the major part of them, at any General Sessions of the Peace to be holden in and for the said County, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to make a rate and assessment on the Parish of Saint Stephen, in the said County of Charlotte, for a sum not exceeding four hundred pounds, for defraying the expense of building, erecting and finishing a Wharf at the Public Landing at Salt Water in the said Parish, for the use of the same, and to make such regulations not inconsistent with the Grant of the said Public Landing, or any previous Act of Assembly relating to the same, for the said Wharf, as to them may seem meet: Provided always, that no greater sum than one hundred pounds shall be assessed by virtue of this Act in any one year.

II. And be it enacted, That the said sum not exceeding four hundred pounds so to be assessed as aforesaid, shall be assessed, collected and paid, agreeably to any Acts in force for assessing, collecting and levying of County or Parish Rates.
