4 Victoria – Chapter 16

An Act to continue and amend an Act, intituled “An Act for the relief of Old Soldiers of the Revolutionary War and their Widows.” Passed 19th March 1841.

I. Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That the Affidavits mentioned in the second and third sections of the said above in part recited Act, having been once made and filed, as provided by the said Act, shall not be required to be made out and filed from year to year, but such Affidavits respectively shall be deemed sufficient without any further repetition thereof, anything in the said in part recited Act to the contrary notwithstanding.

II. And be it enacted, That the applicant under the said Act shall from year to year be required to procure from some Justice of the Peace of the county in which such applicant resides, a Certificate under the hand of such Justice, that he or she is living, and shall file the said Certificate in the same manner as the Affidavits are by the said in part recited Act required to be filed.

III. And be it enacted, That this Act, and the Act of which this is an amendment, shall continue and remain in force until the first day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty.
