4 Victoria – Chapter 4

**An Act in further amendment of the Law. Passed 19th March 1841.**

'Whereas it is customary in this Province to give Notes payable in Timber, Country Produce and other specific articles, and it is expedient to place such Notes on the same footing, as regards the proof of consideration, with Promissory Notes payable in money;'

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That all Notes in writing for a sum certain payable otherwise than in money, shall be deemed and held prima facie to import that they were given for a valuable consideration, in like manner as Promissory Notes for the payment of money.
