4 Victoria – Chapter 9

An Act to authorize the Justices of the Peace in the County of Kent to levy an assessment to pay off the County Debt. Passed 19th March 1841.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That the Justices of the Peace for the County of Kent, at any General Sessions of the Peace hereafter to be holden, or any Special Sessions of the Peace to be for that purpose convened, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to make such rate and assessment of any sum not exceeding two hundred pounds, as in their discretion they may think necessary for the purpose of paying off the Debt of the said County; the same to be assessed, levied, collected and paid agreeably to any Acts now or hereafter to be in force for the assessing, collecting and levying of County Rates.
