5 Victoria – Chapter 3

An Act to repeal at Act, intituled *An Act to prevent the taking of Fish in the different Harbours and River's of this Province with Drift Nets*, so far as the same relates to the County of Western land. Passed 29th March 1842.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That so much of an Act made and passed in the sixtieth year of the Reign of His Majesty King George the Third, intituled An Act to prevent the taking of Fish in the different Harbours and River's of this Province with Drift Nets, as applies to Harbours, Creeks, Coves or Navigable Rivers, in that part of the Province which lies within the County of Westmorland, be and the same is hereby repealed.
