5 Victoria – Chapter 5

An Act to authorize the Justices of the Peace for the County of York to levy a further assessment for the purpose of paying off the Debt due on the erection of a new Goal in the said County. Passed 29th March 1842.

Whereas the expenses occasioned by the erection of the new Gaol in the Town of Fredericton, in York County, are greater than were anticipated in the original design thereof: And whereas the amounts authorized by the former Act to be assessed for that purpose are found insufficient; Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, that the said Justices of the Peace for the said County of York, at any General Sessions of the Peace, or at any Special Sessions of the Peace to be for that purpose holden, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to make such rate and assessment of any sum not exceeding one thousand pounds, as they in their discretion may think necessary for the purpose of paying off the debt due from the County, in the erection of the said new Gaol, the same to be assessed, levied and paid agreeably, and as provided for by any Act or Acts which are now or may hereafter be in force in this Province for assessing, paying, levying and collecting rates for public charges.
