6 Victoria – Chapter 15

An Act to authorize the Justices of the Peace in and for the county of Carleton, to extend the Gaol Limits of the said County. Passed 11th April 1843.

Whereas the Gaol Limits for the County of Carleton are so small and otherwise inconvenient, that it is deemed necessary that they should be extended for remedy whereof,

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That it shall and may be lawful for the Justices of the Peace of the County of Carleton, at any General Sessions of the Peace, further extend the Limits for the Gaol of said County, southerly along the River Saint John, as far as Upham's Creek, so called, and to extend westerly or back from said River one mile.
