6 Victoria – Chapter 2

An Act to amend an Act, intituled *An Act to provide for the payment of Interest on Warrants which are not paid at the Treasury on demand.* Passed 23d March 1843.

Whereas doubts have arisen whether under the provisions of an Act made and passed in the fourth year of the Reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, intituled *An Act to provide for the payment of Interest on Warrants which are not paid at the Treasury on demand*, it is lawful for the Treasurer of the Province to pay any Interest due on Warrants, payment of which has been demanded, unless the Warrant itself shall be paid at the same time;

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That it shall and may be lawful for the Treasurer to pay to the holder or holders of Warrant or Warrants, all sums of money which may be due upon such Warrants for Interest upon the same, although the principal of such Warrants cannot be paid for want of funds in the Treasury; and also the Interest to become due upon all Warrants semi-annually, on the first day of June and the first day of December in every year until such Warrants are paid.
