6 Victoria – Chapter 30

An Act to amend an Act made and passed in the fifth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty Queen Victoria, intituled *An Act to amend the Act relating to Burglary*. Passed 11th April 1843.

Whereas in and by the third Section of the said in part recited Act, it is enacted, That whoever shall be convicted of the crime of Burglary, shall be liable at the discretion of the Court to be imprisoned for the term of the natural life of such offender, or for any term not less than three years: And whereas it is deemed expedient to mitigate the punishment thereby prescribed for the said offence;

I. Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That the said third Section of the same in part recited Act be and the same is hereby repealed.

II. And be it further enacted, That from and after the passing of this Act, whosoever shall be convicted of the crime of Burglary, shall be liable, at the discretion of the Court, to be imprisoned for any term not exceeding fourteen years.
