6 Victoria – Chapter 39

An Act relating to the appointment of Special Constables. Passed 11th April 1843.

Whereas it is expedient to extend the several provisions of an Act made and passed in the seventh year of the Reign of His late Majesty William the Fourth, intituled *An Act to provide for increasing the number of Constables of Saint John, and for appointing Special Constables within the City and County of Saint John*, to the several Counties in this Province;

- I. Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That any two Justices of the Peace in any County in this Province, shall have the like power and authority to appoint persons residing in their several Counties to act as Special Constables in and for any such County, in all respects the same as any two Justices of the Peace in and for the said City and County of Saint John are authorized and empowered in and by the said Act to appoint Special Constables.
- II. And be it enacted, That the several provisions of the said recited Act shall apply and be extended to the said several Counties, and to any Special Constables appointed in pursuance of this Act, to all intents and purposes.
