6 Victoria – Chapter 5

An Act to authorize the Justices of the Peace for the County of York to regulate the Assize of Bread in the Town of Fredericton. Passed 11th April 1843.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That the Justices of the Peace for the County of York be, and they are hereby authorized and empowered from time to time to make such Rules and Regulations for ascertaining and establishing the assize of bread and the sale thereof for the said Town of Fredericton, as they or the major part of them in General Sessions, or at any Special Sessions to be holden for that purpose, shall deem just and expedient, and to enforce such Rules and Regulations under such fines as they or the major part of them shall think fit.
