6 Victoria – Chapter 6

An Act to authorize the Justices of the Peace for the County of York to levy an assessment to pay off the County Debt. Passed 11th April 1843.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That the Justices of the Peace for the County of York, at any General Sessions of the Peace hereafter to be holden therein, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to make such rate and assessment of any sum not exceeding the sum of three hundred and fifty pounds, as they in their discretion may think necessary for the purpose of paying off the County Debt and contingent expenses of the said County; the same to be assessed, levied, collected and paid agreeably to any Acts now or hereafter to be in force for assessing, collecting, levying and paying of the County Rates.
