7 Victoria – Chapter 26

An Act to revive certain Acts relating to the prevention of the importation and spreading of Infectious Distempers within the Counties of Charlotte and Northumberland, and to extend the provision of the same to the Counties of Gloucester and Restigouche. Passed 25th March 1844.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the first year of the Reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, intituled *An Act to make more effectual provision for preventing the importation and spreading of Infectious Distempers within the Towns and Settlements in the Counties of Charlotte and Northumberland*, and also an Act made and passed in the second year of the Reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, intituled *An Act to amend an Act passed in the first year of the Reign of His present Majesty King William the Fourth, intituled 'An Act to make more effectual provision for preventing the importation and spreading of Infectious Distempers within the Towns and Settlements in the Counties of Charlotte and Northumberland,'* be and the same are hereby revived and declared to be in full force during the continuance of this Act.

II. And be it enacted, That the provisions of the Acts herein recited, and by this Act revived, shall extend and be construed to extend to the Counties of Gloucester and Restigouche.

III. And be it enacted, That this Act shall continue and be in force until the first day of May which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty six.
