An Act to continue An Act to revive and continue an *Act to regulate the Driving of Timber and Saw Logs down the River Magaguadavic and its Branches*. Passed 27th March 1845.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the second year of the Reign of Her present Majesty Queen Victoria, intituled *An Act to revive and continue an Act to regulate the Driving of Timber and Saw Logs down the River Magaguadavic and its Branches*, be and the same is hereby continued and declared to be in full force until the first day of May which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty.
