8 Victoria – Chapter 14

An Act to continue an Act to extend the provisions of an Act, intituled *An Act to repeal the Laws now in force for appointing Firewards and the better extinguishing of Fires, so far as the same relate to the Town of Fredericton, and to make regulations more suitable to the said Town, to the Towns of Newcastle and Chatham, and their vicinities, in the County of Northumberland.* Passed 27th March 1845.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the ninth year of the Reign of His Majesty King George the Fourth, intituled *An Act to extend the provisions of an Act, intituled 'An Act to repeal the Laws now in force for appointing Firewards and the better extinguishing of Fires, so far as the same relate to the Town of Fredericton, and to make regulations more suitable to the said Town,* to the Towns of Newcastle and Chatham, and their vicinities, in the County of Northumberland, be and the same is hereby continued and declared to be in force until the first day of May which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty.
