8 Victoria – Chapter 22

An Act to continue an Act for supplying the Town of Saint Andrews with Water by Pipes. Passed 27th March 1845.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the tenth and eleventh years of the Reign of His Majesty King George the Fourth, intituled *An Act to grant John Aymar the privilege of supplying the Town of Saint Andrews with Water by Pipes*, be and the same is hereby continued and declared to be in force until the first day of May which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty.
