8 Victoria – Chapter 23

An Act to continue an Act, intituled An Act for the better and more effectual securing the Navigation of the River Saint Croix, in the County of Charlotte, and also further to continue an Act, intituled An Act to empower the Justices of the County of Charlotte to make regulations for driving Timber and Logs down the Rivers Saint Croix, Magaguadavic, Digdeguash, and their Branches. Passed 27th March 1845.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the tenth and eleventh years of the Reign of His Majesty King George the Fourth, intituled *An Act for the better and more effectual securing the Navigation of the River Saint Croix, in the County of Charlotte*; also, an Act made and passed in the eighth year of the Reign of His Majesty King George the Fourth, intituled *An Act to empower the Justices of the County of Charlotte to make regulations for driving Timber and Logs down the Rivers Saint Croix, Magaguadavic, Digdeguash, and their Branches*, be and the same; are hereby severally continued until the first day of May one thousand eight hundred and fifty.
