8 Victoria – Chapter 24

**An Act to continue the several Acts now in force relating to Tavern Keepers and Retailers.
Passed 27th March 1845.**

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the third year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled *An Act to repeal all the Acts regulating Tavern Keepers and Retailers, and to make other provisions in lieu thereof*; also, an Act made and passed in the fifth year of the Reign of Her said present Majesty, intituled *An Act to amend an Act intituled 'An Act to repeal all the Ads regulating Tavern Keepers and Retailers, and to make other provisions in lieu thereof,'* be and the same are hereby respectively continued and declared to be in force until the first day of April which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty.
