8 Victoria – Chapter 27

**An Act to continue an Act, intituled *an Act to continue the Act relating to Church Wardens and Vestrymen, and to persons having voices in their election, so far as relates to the Parish Church of Saint Andrews.* Passed 27th March 1845.**

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the second year of the Reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, intituled An Act to amend an Act intituled "An Act to repeal an Act passed in the fiftieth year of the Reign of His Majesty King George the Third, intituled 'An Act to declare the qualifications of Church Wardens and Vestrymen in the several Parishes in this Province, and of the persons having voices in their election', and to make other and more effectual enactments in lieu thereof," so far as the same relates to the Parish Church of Saint Andrews, be and the same is hereby continued and declared to be in force until the first day of May which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty.
