8 Victoria – Chapter 30

An Act to continue an Act for the better regulation of the Office of Sheriff in this Province. Passed 27th March 1845.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the sixth year of the Reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, initialed *An Act for the better regulating of the Office of Sheriff in this Province*, be and the same is continued and declared to be in force until the first day of May which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty.
